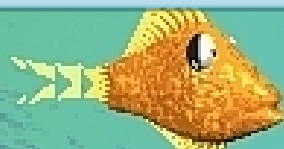
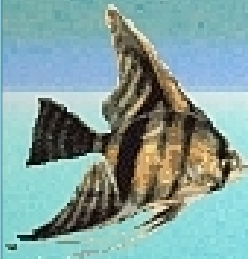


# Children expressed their thoughts through drawing
